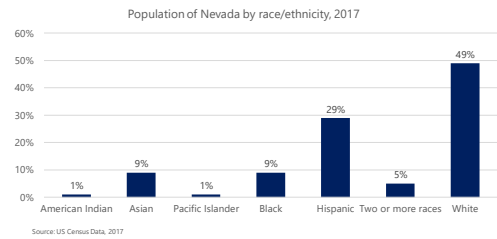

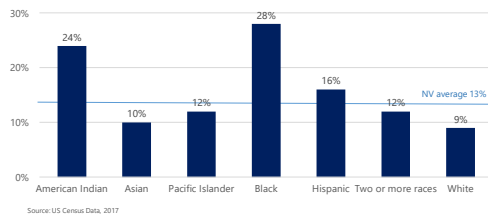

## Nevada is a majority minority state



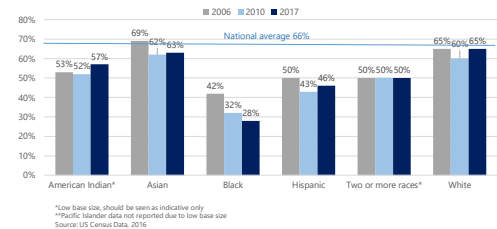

## Poverty by race/ethnicity, 2017



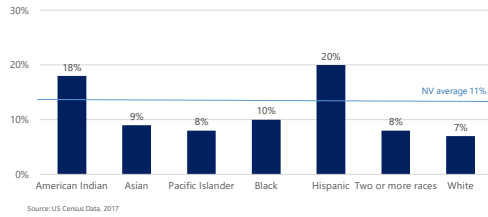

## Home ownership rates in Nevada, 2006-2017



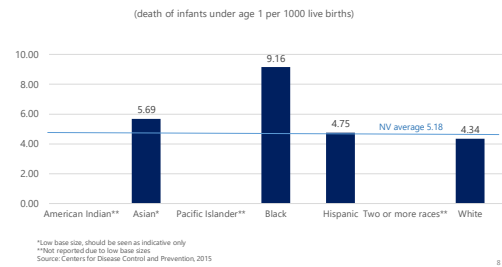

## Percent of Nevadans without health insurance, 2017



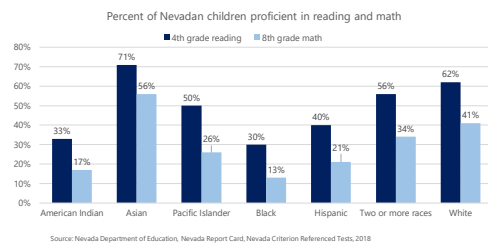

## Infant mortality by race/ethnicity, 2015

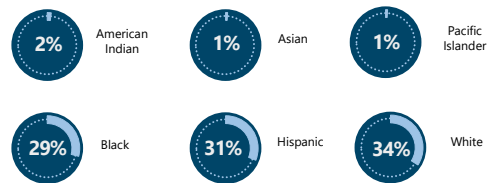

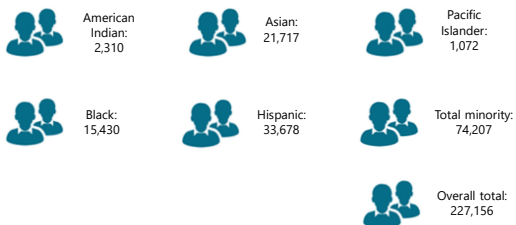
