- As of May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023, we are in the 99<sup>th</sup> day of the 82<sup>nd</sup> NV Legislature session. Legislature timeline:
  - February 6<sup>th</sup> 2023 start of session
  - March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023 last day for bill introductions
  - April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023 is first House passage (bills presented, Committee hearings, debated, amended, postponed, no action, voted, passed)
  - May 26<sup>th</sup> 2023 is second House (bills presented, debated, amended, voted, submit to Governor's office to sign or vetoed)
  - June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023 is end of session
