Community Connect

Community Connect programs work to end food insecurity tomorrow through housing supports, case management, and supportive services that help people achieve long-term stability.

Housing Needs

Currently in Southern Nevada...

- 8,000 individuals are experiencing homelessness.
- FMR has increased by 22% in just two years, but wages have increased 7.5%.
- Grocery costs are the fourth highest in the nation.



Rapid Rehousing

RRH helps individuals and families experiencing homelessness quickly return to stable housing. The goal of the program is to help clients stabilize, build income, and gradually take on full responsibility for their rent, resulting in long-term stability and self-sufficiency.

Permanent Supportive Housing

PSH provides long-term rental assistance and supportive services, ensuring lasting housing stability and security for populations most at risk for housing insecurity or homelessness.



Homeless Prevention

Homeless Prevention provides short-term financial assistance for households experiencing a temporary financial shortfall to ensure they can remain stable in their current housing and avoid experiencing homelessness.

Shared Housing

The Shared Housing program creates sustainable, affordable housing solutions by matching eligible clients with compatible roommates or housemates. Each participant has a private room while sharing common spaces, allowing households to pool resources and significantly lower costs. This model is especially effective for individuals on fixed incomes or living with disabilities, providing them with safe, stable, and affordable housing while fostering community connections.



Supportive Services

In addition to housing-focused programs, The Just One Project offers a range of supportive services through Community Connect that strengthen stability and promote long-term self-sufficiency.
